1. Maintain clear communication among all members

3. Align expectations and understand each individuals role
4. Create shared goals and commitment to the project
5. Maintain regular meetings with all members
 - Brainstorming, problem solving, check-in
6. Identify a conflict resolution plan
7. COMMUNICATION
