### US ARMY W.A.C.'S

- A small contingent of the Women's Army Corps (W ACs), usually between
- 16-24 women were stationed at the Hanford Site. Less than one percent of the Hanford Engineer Works managers and supervisors were women, and most of the professional women were nurses. Despite the lack of equal opportunity, Hanford's women came to the remote desert site and served because they felt a personal dedication to the war effort.



# **Camp Hanford**

- Remnants of Camp Hanford
- Today the role of Camp Hanford is mostly forgotten among the bustle of modern-day clean-up efforts. When the Army decommissioned the camp in 1961, most of the standing structures were demolished (Harvey, 2004, US Army, 1950-1952), however remnants of several of the battery sites can be seen in aerial photographs and the occasional sandbag or communication wire is still found.


