


#### Institute of Medicine 1999:

"The NCPB has concluded that for many Americans with cancer, there is a wide gulf between what could be construed as the ideal and the reality of their experience with cancer care."

#### 2013: Not Better

"The Cancer Care Delivery System is in Crisis"

"Cancer care is often not as patient-centered, accessible, coordinated, or evidence based as it could be."





## Medicare has been a Major Driver Of ASCO Quality Care Programs (Adds more than "Quality").....

- 2015 Medicare Access and CHIP Reauthorization Act (MACRA)
- From piecework to performancebased payment
- Goal of 100% claims paid in value based arrangements
- Private payers participating in/building own models
- Greater patient voice through employer groups and others


