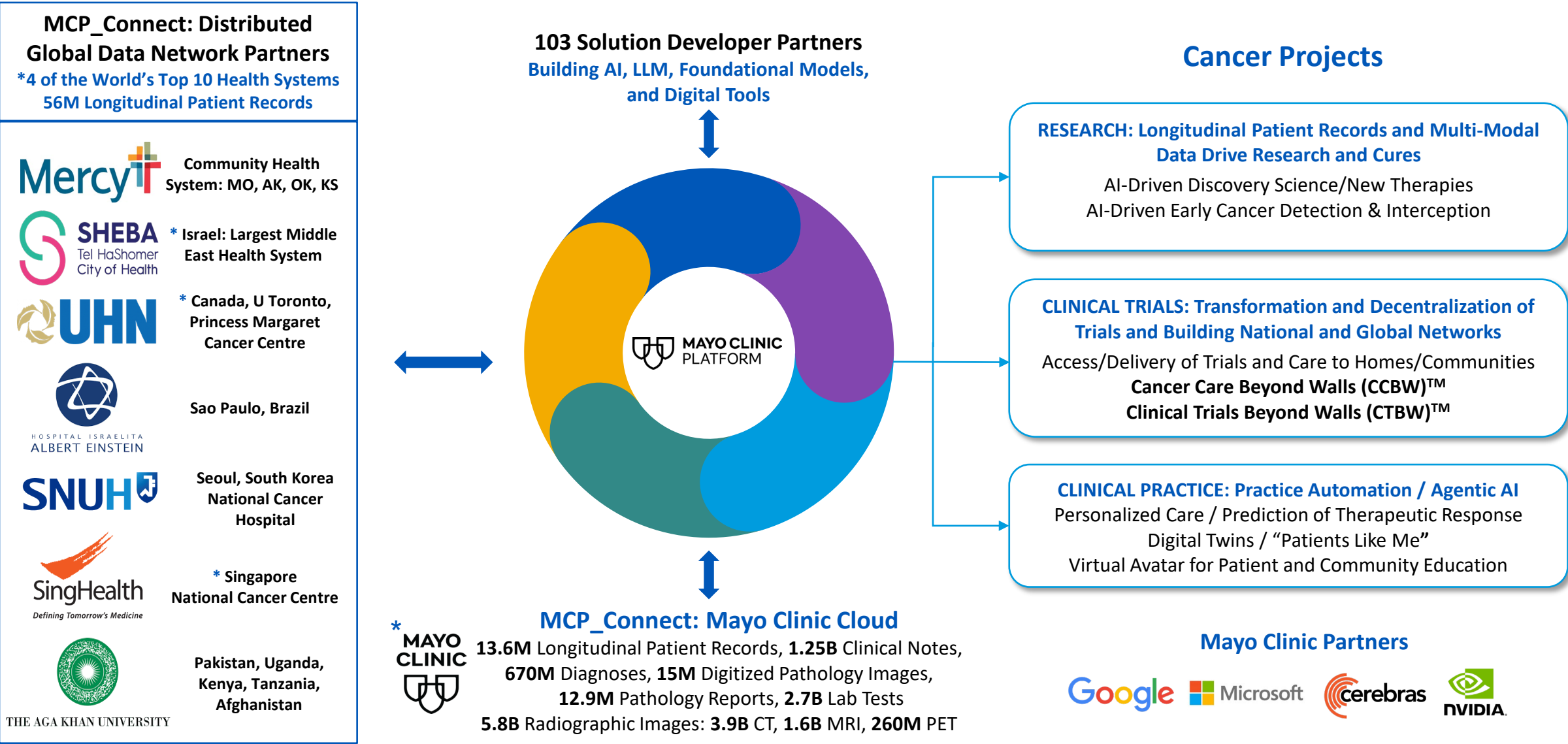

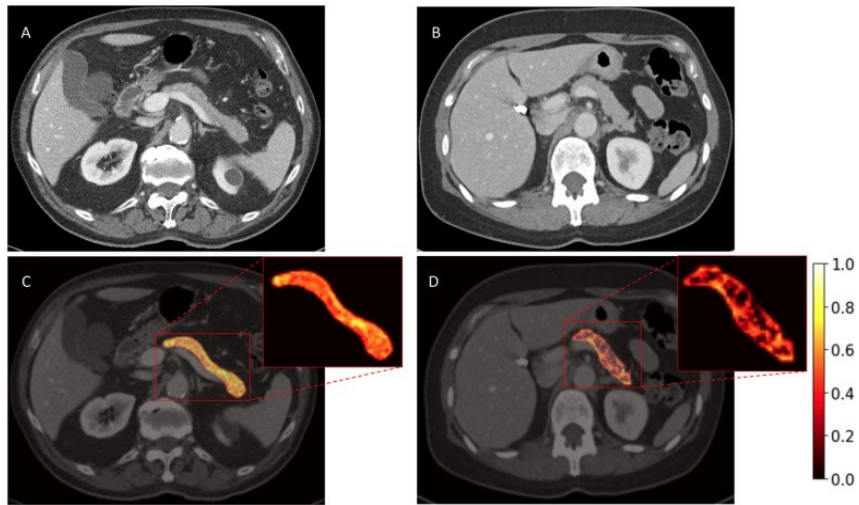

# Mayo Clinic Platform (MCP): Transforming Cancer Research, Trials, and Care Delivery



# Multi-modal, Multi-Step AI Algorithms for Early Detection of Visually-Occluded Pancreatic Cancer

- Developed AI-powered radiomics-based machine learning method capable of detecting visually occult pancreatic cancer in a normal-appearing pancreas on pre-diagnostic CTs at a median of 386 (97–1092) days prior to clinical diagnosis (AUC: 0.98)
- In contrast, inter-reader radiologist agreement was poor: AUC=0.66 (95% CI: 0.46–0.86;  $p < .001$ )
- Validation: The algorithm performed with high specificity in an independent NIH imaging data set (96.2)
- **Development of a Population-Based Screen: AI-PACED Feasibility Study: Automated Risk Stratification, Serial Artificial Intelligence-Augmented Imaging, and Biobanking for Early Detection of Pancreatic Cancer**
  - 10,000 individuals with an elevated risk for PDA will be recruited from all Mayo Clinic sites using an AI-driven screening algorithm: **Enriching New Onset for Diabetes (NOD) for Pancreatic Cancer (ENDPAC)** score and other metabolic and metabolic parameters to stratify individuals (Petersen, Chari (*Gastroenterology* 2018; 155(3):730-739))
  - **Individuals with ENDPAC scores  $\geq 3$  exhibit a 20-fold increased risk of PDA within 3-years**
  - Participants will undergo AI-augmented CT scans at regular intervals, serial biosampling and psychosocial support



## IMPACT

**Potentially Paradigm Shifting, Practice Changing, and Policy Impacting:** this prospective population-based study will seek to validate the AI-based early detection approach on a large scale, with the goal of improving outcomes of sporadic PDA through earlier detection and interception



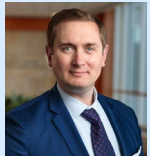

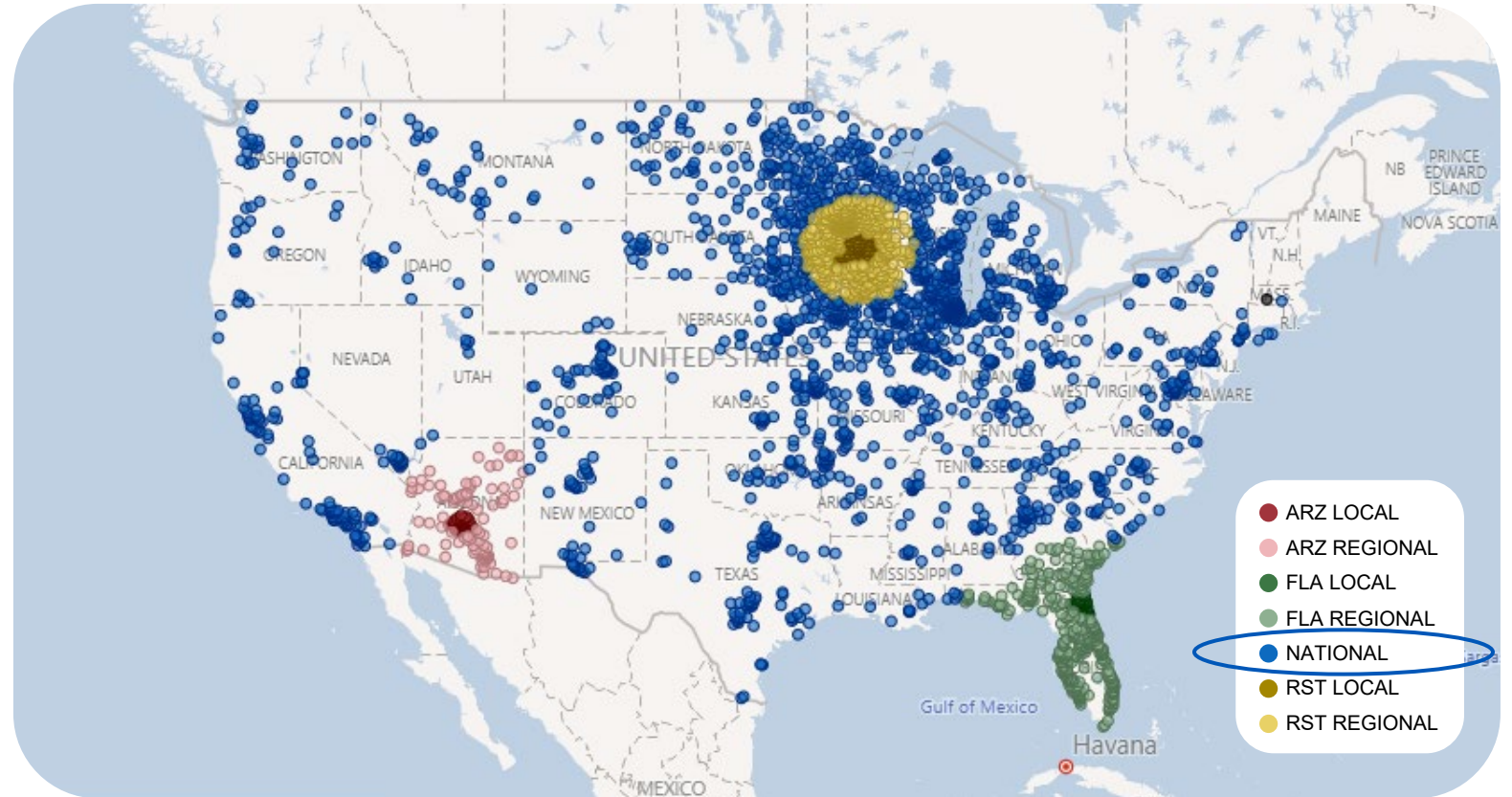

- **Global Sites:** North America, Africa , Europe
- **Project Goal:** Understand the socio-biologic determinants of prostate Cancer disparities and develop tailored, culturally responsive interventions to improve prostate cancer care and survivorship among ethnically diverse Black men
